

### **Administrative Compensation**

Public Act 96-0434, which became law on August 13, 2009, now requires school districts to annually prepare an itemized salary compensation report for every employee holding an administrative certificate. The report shall be presented at a regularly scheduled school board meeting, be posted on the school district website, and be submitted to the Regional Office of Education. It shall include the base salary, pension contributions, retirement increases, cost of health insurance, cost of life insurance, paid sick and vacation day payouts, annuities, and any other form of compensation paid to the school administrator.
